


WHY DOES GOD ALLOW PLAGUES AND PANDEMICS?

WHY DOES GOD ALLOW PLAGUES AND PANDEMICS?

- There are at least 7 reasons why God may allow plagues and pandemics:
 - To Accomplish His Purposes
 - To Teach Obedience
 - To Oppose Pride
 - To Abolish Idolatry
 - To Teach Gratitude
 - To Defend His Holiness
 - To Reveal His Power

WHY DOES GOD ALLOW PLAGUES AND PANDEMICS?

- Recap--To Accomplish His Purposes:
 - One purpose could be to deal with the condition of our hearts.
 - Pharaoh in Egypt had a hardened heart— God dealt with it by allowing 10 plagues.

- For the Egyptians, judgement came in the form of 10 plagues as a result of the hardness (condition) of Pharaoh's heart.
- However, God provided protection for the Israelites. Exodus 12:1-13.

BLOOD (7:14-24)

The Nile, along with all of the water in Egypt, turns into blood. But Pharaoh does not let the Israelites go.



BOILS (9:8-12)

Festering boils break out on the Egyptians and their animals. But Pharaoh does not let the Israelites co.



FROGS (7:25 - 8:15)

Frogs cover the land of Egypt. Pharaoh promises to let the Israelites go, but changes his mind.



HAIL (9:13-35)

Hail strikes down everything in the fields humans, animals and trees. Pharaoh asks for forgiveness and promises to let the Israelites go, but changes his mind.



GNATS (8:16-19)

The dust turns to gnats, which cover the people and animals of Egypt, But Pharaoh. does not let the Israelites go...

LOCUSTS (10:1-20)

Locusts devour every tree and plant in the land of Egypt. Pharaoh asks for forgiveness, but does not let the Israelites go.



FLIES (8:20-32)

Flies fill the houses and land of Egypt. Pharaoh promises to let the Israelites go, but changes his mind.



DARKNESS (10:21-29)

Darkness covers the land of Egypt for three days. Pharaoh promises to let the Israelites go, but changes his mind.



LIVESTOCK (9:1-7)

All of the livestock of the Egyptians die. But Pharaoh does not let the Israelites go.



FIRSTBORN (11:1-10; 12:29-32)

Every firstborn son and firstborn of the cattle in Egypt dies. Pharach finally lets the Israelites leave Egypt, only to change his mind and pursue them to the Red Sea.

- Pandemics in:
- I 320- The Plague (Black Death)
- I 420- Plague Resurgence
- I520- Smallpox (40% died in Mexico)
- I620- Malaria, Bubonic, Yellow Fever
- For the future: Revelation 9:15-20
